

#### From the President

inally, after a cold and soggy Spring, things are starting to warm up around here and we're getting busy. After many months of anticipation, it's finally time for our **forest slab workshop**. If you made a clay slab during the November 2021 meeting, we'll have it available for use at the May meeting. If you're new to the club or if you didn't have a chance to make a slab during the November meeting; we've got you covered! Paul Weishaar and I made and fired 16 additional claw slabs over the past couple of weeks. If you need a slab for this project, we will sell the ones that Paul and I made for \$5 each. The plan for this workshop is a group of 5 trees. Trees will be sold for \$5 each for this project. We will have about 200 small trees available. Out of those, we will have roughly 120 trident maples, 50 bald cypress and about 30 Japanese maples. We want to make sure that everyone wanting to participate will be able to get at least 5 trees for their grove. If we have additional trees left (which we likely will) you can purchase them for \$5 each. The initial workshop fee will be \$25 for 5 trees. You must be a current paid member of the IBC to participate in the workshop. Soil, wire, drain mesh and muck will also be included with the workshop fee. There's been a lot of interest in this workshop, so I expect to have a pretty full meeting room for this workshop. Please bring your bonsai tools if you own some. The summer fun isn't stopping there! Our June tropical bonsai workshop is also on the horizon.

At the May meeting, we'll have a sign-up list for those wishing to participate in the June workshop. I honestly don't know exactly what species of tropical trees we will be using for the tropical bonsai workshop. Here's what I do know: The trees that we get for the tropical workshop normally come in 10 inch plastic pots. We will be shaping the trees and moving them into 10 inch ceramic bonsai pots. The cost of the workshop will be \$50 per person, but the tree you go home with would be a tree that would sell for \$100+ retail. You'll get a good tree at a real good price. Paul Weishaar and I are heading down to Florida to pick up trees for this workshop in a few weeks. We normally try to bring material that is the best looking material we can find and different than the trees that we used during last year's tropical workshop. If this is something that interests you, make sure that you add your name to the sign up sheet so we make sure that we have plenty of trees and pots available. We don't want to come up short on material.

Before I wrap up this month's president's message, I want to briefly bring up the recent Bonsai 101 class. Indy Parks hosted a Bonsai 101 class at the Garfield Park Conservatory on April 9th from 10am - 12pm. Although this was technically an Indy Parks event, it was our IBC members who conducted the program and workshop. I wanted to thank Alyssa Batula, Steve Dick, Bob Hoy and Carl Wooldridge for assisting me with the program. I'm happy to report that we gained a couple additional club members that day.

I look forward to seeing all of you at our upcoming meeting and program. I'm sure that it will be a busy and action packed meeting.
